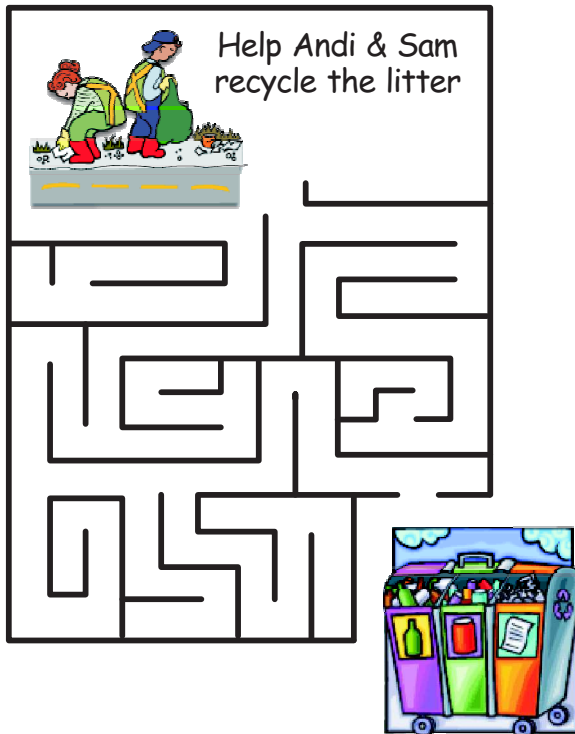

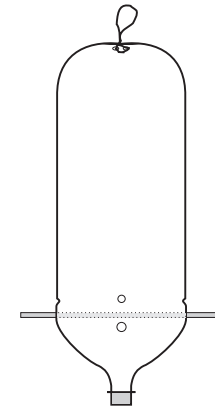

# Recycled Bottle Birdfeeder



1. Remove all the labels and stickers from the bottle, keeping the lid
2. Wash and dry the bottle
3. The bottom of the bottle will be the top of the feeder
4. Drill two small holes in the bottom of the bottle. Thread wire through one hole and out the other. Twist the ends together to make a loop for hanging the feeder. Use a small piece of duct tape or similar to seal the holes so rain cannot get into the feeder
5. Using a drill, make holes that are on opposite sides of the bottle. Insert a piece of dowelling into the pairs of holes
6. Repeat the above step to make several more perches
7. Fill with mixed seeds and replace lid
8. If you want a sunflower feeder, make holes 3 to 5 cm above the perches
